Item of uniform	Guidance / description	Items / uniform variations not permitted
Shoes	<p>Plain black traditional style shoes suitable for school use.</p> <p>Maximum heel height 2"/5cm.</p>	<p>No boots or Ugg style boots, no trainers, no stiletto shoes, no platform soles, no backless shoes, no plimsolls, no dolly shoes.</p> <p>No shoes that have any other colours, branding or marking.</p>

In line with the guidance provided regarding shoes, detailed below are **some** examples of footwear which are **NOT** currently acceptable.

Examples of SOME footwear NOT acceptable	Description
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Suede 'creeper' style ➤ Clear wedge on the sole which is not permitted ➤ Cumbersome style boot
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Skate trainer style shoe ➤ Branding on the heel and tongue ➤ Rubber sole
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Running style trainer ➤ Clear branding with running shoe technology in heel ➤ Plastic upper fabric



- Ugg style boots
- High boot cut
- Cumbersome style boot



- Dolly shoe, offering very little protection
- Poor support
- Too much of the foot is exposed



- Canvas upper
- White rubber midsole, branded
- Offers less support than traditional shoes



- Heel is too high and as such not suitable for day-to-day wear
- Poor support
- Too much of the foot is exposed



- Boot style- not permitted
- Clumsy, too high not suitable for day to day wear
